CONVICT TANG (“manini”) - This is a type of surgeon fish sporting six black bars and a small un-marked scalpel near the base of the tail. The Hawaiian population has an additional bar below the pectoral fin. They like to stay in the protected shallows and are usually only found more along protected rocky coastlines. They feed exclusively on algae. They were a favored fish of old Hawaii. They grow to about 10” and are always found in schools.
