



SCUBA LUV MAUI DIVE REPORT “CRITTER OF THE WEEK”

BIG LONGNOSE BUTTERFLYFISH - “lauwiliwili nukunuku ‘oi’oi “



Slightly larger than the Longnose Butterflyfish and with a longer snout, these rare fish can turn almost black but always have a bright yellow gill spot. They specialize in plucking small crustaceans from the reef with their long snout. They are usually seen in pairs but if no other Big Longnose are around they will hook up with the Yellow Longnose. They grow to about 8”.
