YELLOWMARGIN MORAY (“puhi ”) - Great favorites of divers; easily tamed to hand feed (with caution); they open and close their mouths and swell their necks in an effort to run water over their gills to breath. Hawaii has 40 species of moray eels, all are “nocturnal” with some, like the species above, growing up to 10’. These two big guys like to swim between the “tank” and the “landing craft”. This is a rare shot where they both wanted to get into the same puka and both were standing their ground! When we left they were still working it out....
