HUMPBACK WHALES—February is the height of the season, with mothers bearing their young in our shallow, warm waters. They grow to 45’ and can weigh up to 45 tons. They live off their blubber while in Hawaii, yet calves need 130 gallons of milk each day. They travel in pods of three and start arriving by December. By the end of May, they head to Alaskan waters to feed. Their calls can be heard underwater while scuba diving!
