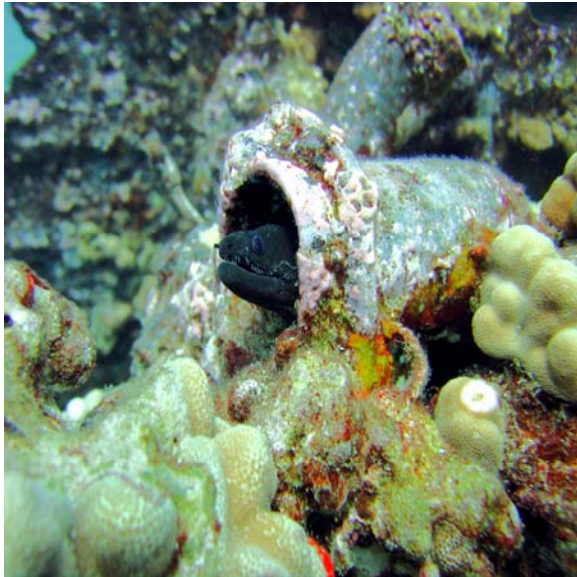


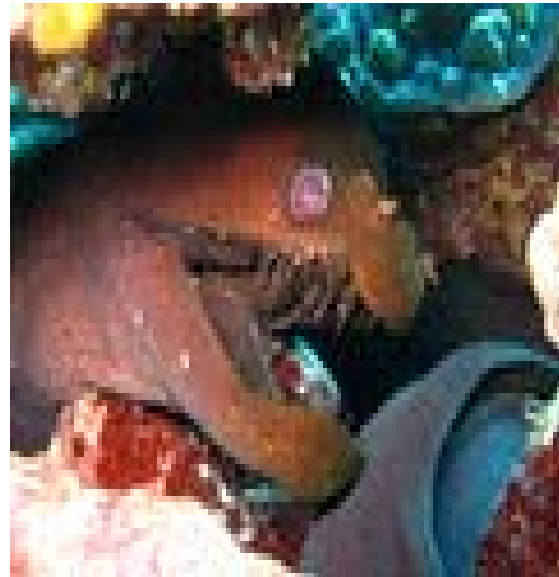

CRITTER OF THE WEEK!

VIPER MORAY - "Puhī Kauila" - Their name in Hawaiian means :” doglike”, in reference to their sharp teeth . Dark brown in color with anterior nostrils and a long, fringed posterior flap; posterior nostrils large and oval; can grow to 5’. When they reach adult size their hooked jaws meet only at the tips, giving them the appearance of a perpetual snarl. The juvenile on the left lives on the TANK for now in a small intake pipe. Even though he is small we are very cautious around him as you should be with any eel!
