SNOWFLAKE MORAY EEL (puhi-kapa”) - The white snout is usually enough to identify this eel if you see him hidden in the rocks; the body is whitish with black speckles and several rows of irregular dark blotches with yellow centers producing a “tie-dyed effect”; they do not have sharp teeth and are considered “docile” in nature. This little guy usually lives on “The Tank” but we have seen him cruising the sand up to 40’ away from the structure!
