

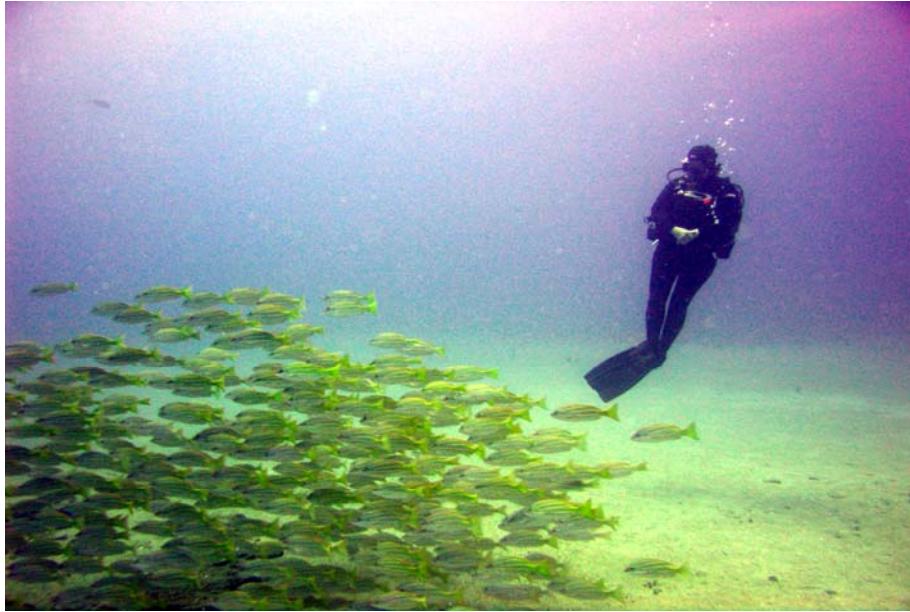

Although introduced to Hawaii from the Marquesas in 1958 for commercial reasons, they have been a flop in Island fish markets. We love to video these guys as they school around divers . You can actually control the school’s movement in the water with a gentle wave of your arm
