GREEN LIONFISH OR HAWAIIAN LIONFISH (nohu)- Unlike it's cousin, the Hawaiian Turkeyfish, this guy's pectoral fins, though large and fanlike lack long, showy spines. Well camouflaged, it often sits at the base of the coral. Easily tamed, this species will often accept food from your hand! This is an endemic species and can grow to 6.5 inches!
