## MARBLED SHRIMP



**Abundant in Hawaii, these bizarre shrimps occur from tide pool depths to over 100'. They are usually only active at night. Males have long claw-bearing limbs for sparring with other. Males reach a length of up to 3". Females bear strange tufts of bristles on their bodies, earning them the name " Fuller Brush Shrimp". Individuals of both sexes are greenish by day and reddish at night. Two animals of the same sex will not live in the same puka as they will fight to the death!**
