WHITEMOUTH MORAY (“puhi l oni’o”) - This is probably the most commonly seen Moray Eel in Hawaii. The body is brown, covered with white spots, and the inner mouth is a bright white. They grow to 3.5 feet and live in pukas in the reef. Like all eels, they breath by rhythmically opening and closing their mouth to move water over their gills. Use caution with all eels and give them their space!
