## CRITTER OF THE WEEK!

HAWAIIAN SPIKEY SEA CUCUMBER ("loli")—Large cucumber studded with fleshy spikes up to 1 1/2 "long; endemic (Hawaiian waters only); grows to about 20"; likes to lie in open sand; feeds slowly by sweeping their downturned mouth back and forth, they are the vacuum cleaners of the ocean; they swallow the sand, filtering out sediment or mud.

There are 1200 species of sea cucumbers worldwide ranging in length from 1" to 6"; many Hawaiian sea cucumbers are nocturnal and some remain unidentified!
