We had a group of four divers on the bottom doing a check of everybody's air...suddenly a shadow hovered over us...it was an 8' manta and she was enjoying the feeling of our exhaled air bubbles rising up against her belly. She circled the group and made eye contact with Steve...he rose off the bottom and she hovered waiting for him. He rose up next to her so close he could have touched her but he did not. He immediately recognized her markings and her gentle, curious personality as a female manta who often frequented us in Makena! She left him and swam to Diana, doing the same thing...eye contact and hovering....We don't know if she recognized the scooters or our blue camoflauge wetsuits but she definitely acted as though we were old friends. We have been smiling ever since .
